FAQ's

- Is there a fee to use the trail? No
- Is the trail open year round? Yes, however, snow is not removed during winter months and caution must be used during snow and ice.
- Who can use the trail? Walkers, joggers, runners, bikers, skateboarders, in-line skaters, rollerbladers, devices for use by persons with disabilities, emergency or maintenance vehicles, motorized golf carts which do not exceed twenty miles per hour.
- Are motorized vehicles permitted? Maintenance or emergency vehicles, wheelchairs, golf carts, and the trail trams are the only permitted motorized vehicles allowed.
- What is the length of the trail? When completed it will run 15 miles; currently, there are 13.7 miles completed.
- In an emergency, who should I call? 911
- If I need to report a problem along the trail, who should I call? Call MCRF, 641.672.2499
- How is the trail construction funded? An initiative of Mahaska Community Recreation Foundation (MCRF) construction is funded through donations, hotel/motel tax, city and county contributions, and grants.

Trailheads

- Edmundson Park 11th Ave West (T39): Restrooms, water, parking, playground, golf, swimming, picnic area.
- Rotary Gazebo Hwy. 92 West: Parking only.
- Bobzilla's Bicycle Werks 1718 Pella Ave: Parking; water; restrooms; bike sales, repairs and accessories. Pella Ave is also known as Old Hwy. 163 or North L Street. (www.bobzillabikes.com)
- Mahaska County Environmental Learning Center at Caldwell Park 2342 Hwy. 92: Parking; water; picnicking; restrooms; natural area; pond; freedom rock; interactive and static displays and environmental education programs.





All Users

- Show courtesy and respect to other trail users at all times.
- Always yield right of way to pedestrians. Give other users consideration and yield right-of-way to ensure safety. Use the right side of the trail, when approaching oncoming trail users, blind spots, or trail tunnels. Pass on the left. Obey all trail rules and posted signs.
- Respect the rights of property owners.
 All laws about alcohol and its use, which apply to traffic on city streets, also apply to the trail.
- Keep dogs on a leash and remove pet feces from trail.
- Travel with a buddy in case of an emergency.
- Trail users are liable for their own actions.

Bicyclists

- Always wear a helmet.
- Yield to pedestrians and rollerbladers.
- Give audible warning (verbal or bell) when passing, rounding a curve, or approaching a tunnel/blind spot.
- Ride at a safe speed.
- Slow down and form a single file in congested conditions or areas where there's reduced visibility or other potentially difficult conditions.

Rollerbladers, Skateboarders, In-line Skaters, and Similar non-motorized devices

- Travel a safe speed.
- Listen for audible warnings of faster trail users getting ready
- Wear helmets and protective gear.
- Be predictable and blade straight.

Golf Carts

- Golf Carts are allowed on the trail
- Golf Carts must not exceed 20 mph
- Give audible warning (verbal or bell) when passing,
- rounding a curve or approaching a tunnel/blind spot. Usage of the trail at night shall require properly installed headlights on the motorized golf cart.

Pedestrians (walkers, joggers, runners)

- Watch out for other trail users.
- Be especially alert when running and when using ear buds
- Listen for audible signals and allow faster trail runner, bicyclists, and users to pass safely.
