Health and Safety

1. Health and Safety Policy Statement

Each user group has their own written safety guidelines and that all of their members will abide by them and those of the Lacey Complex.

2. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

The list of personal protective equipment is available in each concession stand for all users: Eye Goggles, Ear Plugs, Latex Gloves, Face Mask, CPR mouthpieces, Sun Protections, Antibacterial Hand Wipes, and Soap

3. Material Safety Data Sheets - MSDS

All chemicals stored at the Lacey Complex will be listed and an MSDS sheet for each will be located in each concession stand, for review at any time

4. Fire Extinguishers

Fires extinguishers are located in each concession stand. The location is clearly marked on the facility map. **In an emergency call 9-1-1.**

5. First Aid/AED Machines

An AED machine will be stored in a metal cabinet, attached to the outside of each concession stand. If you have to use the AED, **please call 9-1-1 and follow the instructions the AED gives you.**

The facility provides an emergency first aid kit in all AED cabinets.

6. Emergency Response Plan

The location of emergency vehicle entrances will be determined and communicated to the fire department, emergency ambulance service, and local authorities annually. If required, helicopter evacuation of injured people will be the closest field not in use.

In case of a tornado warning, you will be asked to evaluate the complex. There is not a tornado shelter at the complex.

Scheduled activities and season calendars are automatically updated on the MCRF website.

7. Emergency Communications

The PA system will be the primary communication tool in case of an emergency. Cell phones and word of mouth are secondary options.

Weather and Field Conditions

1. Field use when fields are wet/soft will be determined by the facility manager before practices and games. Field closures will be posted and emailed by 3pm each day.

2. It is the policy of the Lacey Complex that no activities will be held while a severe weather warning is in effect. During this warning period no one is allowed on the fields.

3. If a tornado warning is issued, patrons should leave the complex. Please note the concession stand is not a certified tornado shelter.
