MANAGER ITEMS OF IMMEDIATE IMPORTANCE

The following items are time sensitive and should be completed as quickly as possible after your state championship game. Email items 1 and 2 within 24 hours of receiving this packet to Tournament Director MaKenzie Burk; makenzie.burk@mcrf.mahaska.org. Do **NOT** send via text message.

1. Team Information Sheet

- If you cannot download the form, a copy is included in this packet. If you cannot type your information into the editable form and must enter by hand, the information must be legibly written and easily readable.

2. Photo of Your Team *(Preferably with your State Championship banner)*

3. Affidavit Book/Binder

If possible, we need to receive your affidavit and supporting documents before the rush of arrival day. Hopefully all of your documents will be perfectly in order, but the few hours between your arrival at the ballpark and the start of games is not ample time to resolve issues if they are not. In recent years, teams have successfully submitted their affidavit and supporting information as scanned documents on Google Docs or by email. **Please call or text MaKenzie Burk (641) 670-0123 to make arrangements to submit your affidavit and supporting documents as soon as possible.**

4. Tournament Shirts & Ball Order Forms *(Shirt Link and Ball Order Form provided in this packet)*

Submit your team's pre-tournament order by midnight on **Wednesday, July 16, 2026**. This is the deadline to make sure you have a shirt there will be very few sizes for sale on site, we will also have tournament balls on site for purchase.

Items of importance to bring to Oskaloosa:

1. Affidavit Book/Binder

Even if you submit your affidavit documentation early, you need to present your affidavit book/binder to the tournament director immediately upon your arrival at the tournament site on arrival day. **DO NOT FORGET YOUR AFFIDAVIT AT HOME! THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!** Someone from home will be rushing this to Oskaloosa if you forget it!

2. State Championship Banner

Your team will parade on stage with your banner during the Welcome Ceremony.



3. Pin Trading

Pin trading at tournaments is a Little League tradition. It is customary for teams to exchange pins during pre-game introductions. Try to bring an adequate number of pins that represent your league or district. It is recommended that you bring around 150 pins to the state tournament. Umpires, staff, and teams that you do not match up with will have pins to trade as well.

Other items of importance to know before coming to Oskaloosa:

1. We Play by Little League Rules

This is a Regional Tournament. Little League rules, processes, and procedures should not be a surprise to managers and coaches.

2. Coach Attire

Collared shirts are preferred, but tee shirts are permitted if they are team-associated and in good taste. No cut-off shirts, tank tops, or sleeveless shirts. Pants shall be long pants or shorts. No short-shorts, cut-off shorts, or gym shorts. Footwear must be closed-toe, no sandals, flip flops, or Crocs. Spikes/Cleats are NOT to be worn by Managers/Coaches.

3. Pre-Game Equipment Inspections

Little League rules no longer require pre-game equipment inspections but that does not mean equipment will not be checked. Equipment compliance ultimately is the responsibility of the team manager and penalties can be harsh. The umpires will outline their plan for inspecting equipment at the coaches meeting on the afternoon of Wednesday July 22nd. Please instruct your players to not even bring illegal or damaged equipment to Oskaloosa. Equipment that is damaged or not in compliance with Little League regulations will be confiscated, stored in the 5-plex building, and returned after a team's last game.

SEVERE WEATHER PLAN

The Tournament Directors will appraise the weather situation at the start of each day and before the start of each game. We will continue to monitor the weather throughout the game. The Tournament Director will be the final word on whether field conditions are safe for play.

Lightning

The tournament directors will use the app WeatherBug to detect lightning within 10 miles of the Lacey Recreation Complex. If lightning is detected within 10 miles, the field will be evacuated and the game will be suspended for 30 minutes from the time of the last detected lightning strike within the 10 mile radius.

Severe Weather Warnings

The tournament facility does not offer appropriate protection in case of severe weather. Should a severe weather warning be announced we will require the evacuation of the complex, teams and fans must leave the ballpark to seek appropriate shelter. The Tournament Directors will maintain communication with the team manager. The team manager will relay information to the team.

Heat Issues

Team Managers will be responsible for the hydration level of their players. Late July in Central Iowa can be exceptionally hot and humid. Appropriate hydration is vital. The Lacey Recreation Complex, will have a Water Monster placed on site, that will provide filtered water for all teams and spectators. Thanks to the Mahaska County Emergency Management Agency. Athletes and coaches should begin each game well hydrated and continue hydrating during the game. Little League encourages players to drink at least eight (8) ounces of water or Gatorade drink at least every 15 minutes during the game. Should heat reach dangerous levels, games may be postponed until evening.



PRACTICE FACILITIES & PROCEDURES

- Practice times will be available at the Lacey Recreation Complex Daily - 2104 Stadium Drive, Oskaloosa, Iowa 52577. There are 6 regular fields available for practice. Teams will only be able to use 1 field per team per time slot (unless unscheduled). There is 1 all turf field (semi-finals and championships will be played here) that will be available for practice each day in a 1-hour time slots.
- Time Slots will run from 8AM - 8PM. No team will be permitted to be at the practice site after 8PM. Only 1 practice time per team per day will be provided in a two-hour practice time slot (on regular fields and one-hour time slot on all turf field).
- Practice Times are first come, first served, using the Signup Genius and organized with MCRF General Manager, MaKenzie Burk (makenzie.burk@mcrf.mahaska.org). The link to the Signup Genius will be provided to all managers and coaches no earlier than July 20, 2026, and teams may schedule practice from that point using that link.
- Batting Cages on-site at the Lacey Complex are reserved for teams playing that day. Depending on availability we may open up batting cage times for evenings.
- Indoor batting cages and facilities are available at the Oskaloosa Indoor Sports Complex, Contact Dave Fonkert for scheduling and pricing at 641-229-6446 or by email at oskypridebaseball@yahoo.com. Teams may organize this with the Oskaloosa Indoor Sports Complex independent of Little League and do so at their own risk.

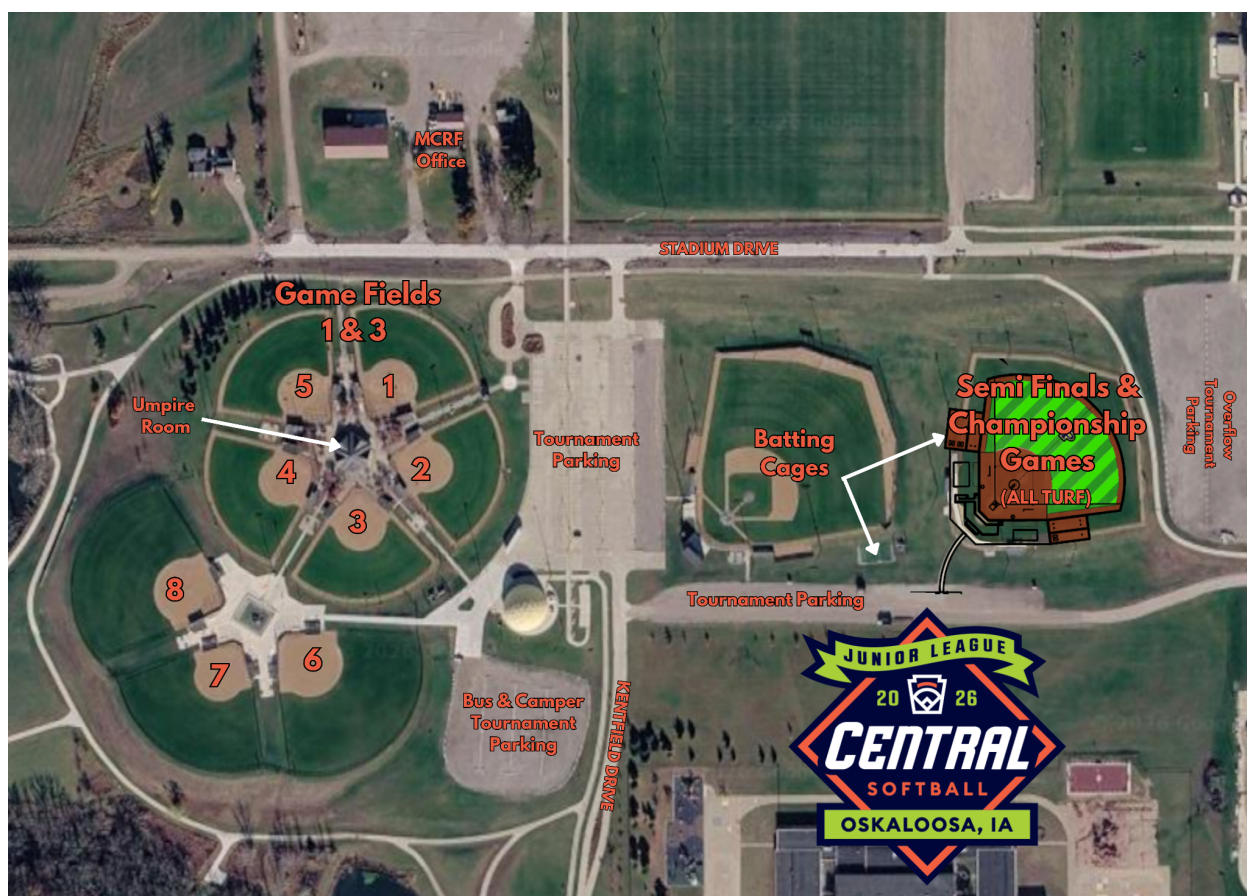

Complex Address: 2104 Stadium Drive, Oskaloosa, Iowa 52577

Parking Information: Primary parking for the tournament will be the large paved lot with entrances off of Stadium Drive and Kentfield Drive. There is ADA Parking available in the front row of each parking lot. For the Semi-Finals and Championship games there is parking directly south of the field and an additional overflow lot to the east of the field. **DO NOT** park in the grass or create your own spot. There is plenty of parking at the complex. Please be respectful of the complex and others around you at the event.





Junior League Softball Central Regional Complex Rules

The following items and activities are strictly prohibited on any of the facilities of the Junior League Softball Central Regional:

- Pets of any kind (except certified service animals)
- Alcohol
- Illegal Drugs
- Any kind of tobacco, vaping, or smoking products
- Weapons of any kind
- Skateboards, hover boards, rollerblades, scooters, and similar items
- Noisemakers (ex:vuvuzelas, thunder sticks, air horns, cow bells, etc.)
- Fireworks
- Drones
- Solicitation
- Laser Pointers
- Flash photography (during games)

Photographers: Only official tournament photographers are permitted inside the fence, including foul ball territory. Flash photography is dangerous to the players and is prohibited.

Broadcasting / Online Streaming: Little League International has the exclusive right to authorize any and all broadcasting and webcasting (live or recorded) of tournament games. Broadcasting and/or webcasting of audio or video of the Junior League Softball Central Regional is prohibited unless contractually authorized by Little League International.

We welcome broadcasters/webcasters contractually authorized by Little League, but the scorer's table cannot be used as broadcast locations due to insufficient space. Contact Tournament Director Dave Rodgers (641) 295-9691 to make arrangements. All Games will be streamed on MuscoVision:

Outside Food: The Junior League Softball Central Regional respectfully requests that no outside food, drinks, coolers and grills be brought to the tournament site except for team dugout refreshments. There are concessions and food trucks on site for your convenience. The proceeds from concessions help offset tournament expenses.

Pop-up Chairs and Canopies: These items are permitted, but respect fellow spectators. You will be asked to take your canopy down if it obstructs the view of other spectators.

Unruly Fans: Iowa District 4, Mahaska Community Recreation Foundation, Central Region, and Little League expect good sportsmanship from all coaches, players, and spectators. In that spirit, we ask that everyone act responsibly and courteously to those around you. Abusive language or disorderly conduct directed at players, coaches, officials, or spectators are not acceptable and are grounds for removal from the premises. Such action could also jeopardize the eligibility of the participating teams within the Little League International Tournament

WORLD SERIES AIRLINE ROSTER

Immediately following the championship game and before our champion team leaves the ball park, we will need to submit the airline roster to Little League so they can arrange for the team's flight to Kirkland, Washington for the World Series.

One item some of you might not be prepared for is that teams with all male coaching staff must have an adult female who will travel with the team to the World Series and serve as the team's player advocate. This is not a requirement for the regional, but it is for the World Series. This person must be included on the airline roster. If you have an all-male coaching staff, please have your female player advocate selected and be sure she is willing to make the trip to Washington state for the World Series. Teams with at least 1 female coach will not need a player advocate.

For the airline roster, we will include all players, 1 manager, 2 coaches, and 1 player advocate if needed. No one else will be on the airline roster. First, middle, and last names will be required on the airline roster along with the birthdate and gender of each person.

From past experience, there are many things the winning manager would rather be doing than putting the airline roster together immediately following the championship game. The airline roster is included in this packet so you can complete it and have it ready should it be needed.
